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# Aims of the pilot projects:

- To produce learning materials for students in social and health care vocational training programmes who are preparing for transnational work placements (abroad)
- To increase students' understanding of care work in different countries
- To expand provision of English-written learning materials suitable for students during their initial vocational training
- To produce a general format for organising foreign work placements and preparing students for practical training periods abroad
- To harmonise the supervising procedures for the students during their transantional work placements
- To harmonise the assessment procedures used during transantional placements
- To create a model for developing similar learning materials for vocational education

The ETM II –pilot project is a direct continuum for preceding ETM –pilot project.

Final products of both projects form an extensive learning resource package.
