



#### **Important Dates**

- October 16, 1940 Tallinn Medical School was founded;
- 2002 Basic nursing education studies started in Kohtla-Järve Medical School;
- 2005 Tallinn Medical School became a higher education institution and was renamed Tallinn Health Care College;
- 2006 Kohtla-Järve Medical School became a structural unit of Tallinn Health Care College;
- 2007 studies started in Pärnu Hospital.

  - 2016/2017


### **Practical Training**

Wide network of practical placements all over Estonia;


 Individual support is provided by the mentor at the practical placement, supervisor at the college and the







#### Libraries


- Tallinn Health Care College has a library both in the college building in Tallinn as well as in Kohtla-Järve structural unit;
