


Foundation of Estonian UAS

- Applied (professional) higher education is higher education of the first cycle, the purpose of which is to acquire the competencies necessary for working in a certain profession or for continuing studies at the master's level;
- Today Estonian Rectors' Conference of UAS includes
 10 Estonian universities of applied sciences:
 - 2 private institutions;
 - 8 state professional higher education institutions.

Important Dates

- October 16, 1940 Tallinn Medical School was founded;
- 2002 Basic nursing education studies started in Kohtla-Järve Medical School;
- 2005 Tallinn Medical School became a higher education institution and was renamed Tallinn Health Care College;
- 2006 Kohtla-Järve Medical School became a structural unit of Tallinn Health Care College;
- 2007 studies started in Pärnu Hospital.

 - 2016/2017


Practical Training
