## RESIDENCE PERMIT

All incoming students from the European Union who stay in Estonia for longer than 90 days must first register themselves at the local municipality and thereafter at the Citizenship and Migration Bureau. The student will receive an ID-card of the Republic of Estonia, which can be widely used, for instance for giving digital signatures, identifying oneself in a virtual environment, lending books from the library.
